3. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

CAUTION: Follow the directions for use. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Before each use, patch test a small area you wish to treat and wait 24 hours before using product to ensure you have no adverse skin reactions. Contains Thioglycolate.

DO NOT use on irritated, sunburned, inflamed or broken skin, on skin which has been shaved in the last 72 hours or on skin which has suffered an adverse reaction to hair removal lotions in the past.

DO NOT use on face or ears, on moles, breast nipples, perianal or genital areas. If discomfort or irritation occurs during use, remove the product immediately and rinse area with cold water. If irritation persists, consult a physician or call a Poison Control Centre.

In the event of contact with the eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of lukewarm water, remove any contact lenses and continue to rinse with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Consult a physician or call a Poison Control Centre immediately. Show the packaging when seeking medical assistance.

DO NOT swallow. Failure to follow use directions may result in chemical burns. Always wait 24 hours before applying an antiperspirant, perfume or astringent lotion.

Always wait 72 hours between product applications. **DO NOT** sunbathe or swim for 24 hours after use. Avoid contact with jewelery. For external use only!
